CloverField K9



Membership Fees:

- Annual Membership (Per Calendar Year): \$150
 - Membership is good for 2 dogs handled by the same person. \$20/additional dog.
- Annual Membership (Per Calendar Year) if joining after June 30: \$100
 - Membership is good for 2 dogs handled by the same person. \$20/additional dog.

Practice Fees:

- \$20 Members Nights
 - 1 dog per handler, \$5/additional dog
- \$30 Instructional Practices
 - 1 dog per handler, \$5/additional dog
- \$40 Instructional Practices for **non-members** first 2 practices (try-and-buy, before committing to membership).
- \$50 Instructional Practices for non-members after first 2 practices if membership not obtained

Members Nights:

- Members nights are un-guided practice windows for CloverField K9 GRC Members
 - Members will be welcomed to come practice GRC activities using CloverField K9's equipment without instruction.
 - o This will be monitored by CloverField K9 staff, but no instruction will be given.
 - Friends may help each other as friends, but trainers may not offer paid coaching opportunities during Members Nights.
 - This is "modified drop-in-style".... meaning: come one, or come all... but registration is due 24 hours in advance.
- Members nights are for members only
- Members may always use Members Nights to practice SR and Spring Pole. Other activities
 will rotate and CloverField K9 will notify members which activities are available with 1
 week's notice.

Instructional Practices:

- Instructional Practices are formal gatherings where one of our trainers will be teaching a specific GRC activity at a designated time.
- Instructional Practices are open to members and non-members, however members will receive 24 hour advanced notice for booking, and a discounted rate.
- MODIFICATION AS OF APRIL 1, 2025: After a membership poll, it has been decided that rather than a monthly instructional practice, members will receive a discounted rate, and advanced registration at CloverField K9's offerings to the public of things like wall-climb.

Calendar and Frequency of Opportunities:

- Members-Nights will be available *approximately* once per week
- There will be *at least* 1 Instructional Practice per month (see update above)
- Monthly offerings will be published the month prior so people can plan ahead
- There will be *at least* one GRC event per year. Members are *required* to attend. See Membership Rules below for details.

Membership Benefits and Rules:

- GRC Requires EVERY club to host 1 event per year. All members must volunteer at our
 event even if you are not participating. If you have a scheduled conflict at that time, you
 must notify CloverField K9 within 1 week of the date being announced or there will be a
 fee of \$50 to hire a non-member to cover your responsibilities at the event.
- Members receive 24-hour advanced notice for all scheduled practices before they are announced publicly.
- Members receive a discounted rate on all practices.
- Members receive 1 free cancellation for any practice they sign up for and can no longer attend per calendar year.
- Membership can be revoked due to unsportsmanlike conduct. Membership fees will not be refunded.
- Members must be at least 18 years of age to join, per GRC rules unless they are GRC members under a family account and a parent or legal guardian will be attending every practice and event with them.
- Members are not required to have an active membership with GRC, but you will need a membership to be eligible to compete in any competition.

• Membership is open to dogs of all levels, but all dogs may not be ready for competition.

Where Do The Fees Go?

- Your fees will go towards maintenance, upkeep, and enhancements of the training and competition grounds and equipment as well as hosting GRC events. Members may ask to see the books at any time.
- CloverField K9 is donating the use of their already established equipment and facility without reimbursement from the club. The club will be responsible for covering wear-and-tear for increased usage.
- Membership Fees are non-refundable
